



TOWN OF DAYTON, MAINE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP

General Notes:

- 4.) The extent of the Critical Rural Zone of the Dayton Zoning Ordinance cannot be accurately depicted on this plan and therefore must be determined by on-site inspection.
- 5.) Streams depicted hereon have been compiled from USGS Quadrangles as specified in Section 4.2 of the Dayton Zoning Ordinance. It is the responsibility of the landowner to determine the status and existence of potential perennial streams.
