### **EXECUTIVE SESSION:**

### **OLD BUSINEES:**

1. Transfer station pricing on repairs & dumpster. The cost to repair the transfer station was \$255 and to haul the dumpster is \$750.
2. Gould Rd. At this point information is being gathered to determine next steps.
3. EcoMaine silver bullet. A meeting has been scheduled for May 17<sup>th</sup> at 5 pm.
4. 2010-2011 budget. Angela Cushman, Treasurer, reviewed several items regarding the budget – audit fees, tax maps, county tax, roads, fire department, education and ball field mowing. Some discussion was held regarding the potential mil rate and amounts used for excise tax and surplus to offset the total amount needed to be raised with taxes.
5. Recycling bin sale. Angela Cushman communicated that the recycling bin sale went well. However, we have to place minimum orders and would need to order more than ordered in the hopes to sell items.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Twelve Town. Millie Tuttle provided an update to the Selectmen regarding Twelve Town activities. MaineDOT has provided a map showing which roads will be turned over to the towns for maintenance. Before turning over to the town, DOT will repair the road. There is a 2 mile stretch that would be turned over to Dayton. Some towns will get up to 22 miles. This proposal will be

presented to the Transportation Committee in Augusta in the fall. The development of a county charter will be another project that will be occurring over the next year.

2. Poverty abatement. Angela Cushman communicated that there is an individual that has received poverty abatement from the town who is appealing the decision to the York County Commissioners. Angela has provided information to the county commissioners. A hearing will be held either on May 19<sup>th</sup> or June 2<sup>nd</sup>.
