OLD BUSINEES:

1. Gould Rd. Mike Souliere, Road Commissioner, has put together bid specs (800 ft of ditching & culvert) for the work that needs to be completed on Gould Rd. Mike will be responsible for cutting down the 17 trees. Jim Roberts did speak with an abutter regarding cutting of some trees and the resident was okay. The water tests conducted on Buzzell Rd came back acceptable. Angela Cushman to put together a bid package and advertise for the work on Buzzell Rd and mowing for the ballfield.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Request for information from UMO regarding a list of landowners. The Selectmen agreed to have Michelle Boisjoly, Tax Assessor, provide land owner information only and not to include building information.
2. Volunteer Accident Insurance. The Selectmen agreed to continue coverage for volunteers.
3. TRIO Clerk's package. Angela Cushman provided information to the Selectmen regarding the clerk's package. The package would cover birth, death & marriage licenses, dog licenses and appointments and costs \$2,000. This package would allow the clerk to be more efficient and accurate.
4. Education budget increase. The last update on the education budget for the town shows an increase of \$113,000 over last year. Information regarding this increase will be placed on the website and the newspapers.

5. Deputy Registrar of Voters. In the event that Janice Saunders, Registrar of Voters, is unable to make Monday nights RSU 23 Regional Budget Meeting, then Yvonne Shaw will need to become a deputy. Shirley Harrison, Registrar of Voters for Lyman, is willing to meet with Yvonne over the next couple days to ensure we are all ready for Election Day. Election workers have been called and a schedule has been formed.
