

SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

October 10, 2011

Selectman Scott Littlefield declared the meeting open at 18:00.

Agenda approved by Selectmen.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

APPOINTMENTS:

OLD BUSINEES:

1. Time Warner. Jim Roberts stated that he met with Jamie Marshall, Maine Video Systems, and Steve Crain, Audio Design, and is awaiting proposals back on the requirements and costs for televising meetings from the Municipal Building.
2. Fire Commission. Jim Roberts stated that he is meeting with David Ordway on Wednesday, Oct. 12th to finalize the Purchase & Sale agreement and the Personnel policy. The Selectmen also received a copy of a letter from Chief Carpenter stating that he is withdrawing his name from the applicants for the full time chief's position. The next Fire Commission meeting is scheduled for Oct. 13th at 6:30 pm at the Dayton Municipal Building.
3. Road updates. Mike Souliere stated that the Bickford Road is finished and some work still remains on the Dennett Road. He also stated that he excavated a soft spot on the Anderson Road near the turn-around and made it ready for Dayton Sand to pave. The paving at the transfer station is now complete. Mike will look at Maple Drive as a follow up to a complaint sent to the Town.
4. York County Fish & Game Club. Jim Roberts stated that he has spoken with Phil Audlos from the club and was advised that they are working on a solution. Mike Polakewich stated that he spoke with George Sutton, Member of the York County Fish & Game Club, concerning the number of complaints that the town has

received since the trees have been cut at the club. Mike informed George that the town would take action if the club did not come up with a plan to lessen the increase in the noise level. It was also noted that the pistol range has been closed until further notice.

5. Parking Ordinance. The Selectmen were presented with a copy of the amendments to the Dayton Parking Ordinance. After some discussion it was decided to also include a provision for town wide winter parking bans.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Snowplowing: Paul Poirier was in seeking a five year extension for his snowplowing contract. It was stated that any contract would need to be voted on at the Annual Town Meeting. The Selectmen stated that they would discuss it and inform Paul of their decision.
2. The Selectmen discussed travel time and mileage reimbursement and felt that this issue needs to be addressed.

PUBLIC FORUM:

1. John Gay stated that there was a pothole on Buzzell Road near Piersons Nursery and another one on Murch Road near the Old Gordon Road. Mike Souliere will inspect both locations.

CORRESPONDENCE:

There were two complaints concerning taxes. Mike Polakewich stated that he would follow up with a letter and include a copy of the Dayton newsletter.
