1. Public Hearing for Apple Blossom Lane. The Selectmen will hold a virtual public hearing on Monday, June 29th at 6pm to answer any questions regarding the referendum question asking the Town to vote to accept Apple Blossom Lane as a town way. If the town votes to accept the lane then the snowplow contract will increase by a \$1,000 annually.
2. Elections & Annual Town Meeting. Maine Municipal Association has provided some resources for Towns to use when preparing for elections and annual town meetings. Staff is in the process of reviewing the information and will determine steps to implement as necessary.




