**APPOINTMENTS:**

**OLD BUSINESS:**

1. Buzzell Road culvert. The Selectmen rejected all bids and are going back out to bid based on new specifications. New bids are due on July 10<sup>th</sup> at 6PM.

2. Roads Financing. A workshop will be scheduled for July 17<sup>th</sup> at 6PM with the following individuals being invited: Fire Chief, School Board, Fire Commission Chair and Richard Ranaghan & Brian Dudley, Northeast Municipal Advisors, to start developing a capital improvement plan.
3. Roads. Dan Gay asked about the next steps for the turnaround on Steele Rd. It was decided that Dan Gay will approach one of the residents on Steele Rd to discuss a possible turnaround.
4. Fire Commission. Casella will be paying for the damages to the ladder truck. David Ordway, Town Attorney, is still reviewing the changes to the Interlocal Agreement.
5. Waste Management contract. The Selectmen reviewed the amendment agreement and agreed to sign to the extension to the current contract for another three years. The contractor called to inform the town that a resident dumped oil into the trash which is not allowed per the contract. All Dayton residents will be reminded via the website and a letter will be sent directly to residents on the road where the oil was dumped.

6. Time Warner. Tony Vigue, consultant, via email provided an update on the status on the franchise renewal. Now that Spectrum has purchased Time Warner the renewal process has slowed down a little.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Dump permit fee increases. **Jarod Harriman made a motion to increase the dump permit to \$25 for 3-cubic yards effective July 1<sup>st</sup> 2017 and can only purchase one a year; 2<sup>nd</sup> Dan Gay. Passed 3/0.**
2. Snowplow contract review. The Selectmen reviewed the current contract in preparation for meeting with the contractor.

#### **PUBLIC FORUM:**

Jim Roberts communicated that a resident in the area of the parking lot for the dam is complaining that people are parking along the road ways. Dan Gay will connect with Matt LeBlanc to discuss how to approach the issue.

Angela Cushman communicated that the Town received a Notice of Claim from Fairpoint regarding damage to a utility pole. This claim does not appear to belong to the Town. The notice has been referred to the Town Attorney to refute.

Jim Roberts communicated that the resident that was sent a code violation notice did not pick up the certified mail. The notice was sent again by regular mail.
