

SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

July 20, 2020

*Selectman Scott Littlefield declared the meeting open at 6:00 PM.
Selectmen approved agenda.*

APPOINTMENTS: N/A

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Roads/Mullet Lane. Discussion was held regarding the turnaround on Mullet Lane. The Selectmen, Mike Souliere and Jim Roberts will conduct a site walk on Mullet Lane prior to the next Selectmen Meeting. Mike Souliere stated that Dayton Sand & Gravel will be hired to do the shoulder work from Route 35 thru Route 5. Mike will take care of the guardrail areas. DS&G averages \$6,500 per day for shouldering. Gould Rd will be repaired this week and then the roads will be striped.
2. Waste Management Contract/Transfer station sign. After review of the new agreement with Pine Tree Waste the Selectmen are requesting one more change prior to signing. The Selectmen decided that 3 additional recycling bins will be added to the transfer station. Only one recycling dumpster will be unlocked at a time to ensure bins are full prior to being hauled. Signage will be added to the transfer station and education on recycling will be sent out again to residents.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Town Dennett Property. Dylan Anderson presented a scout project that he would like to complete on the Dennett Property. The Selectmen approved of the project but asked for more details before beginning any work.
2. 457B Retirement Plan. The Selectmen approved having all employees be able to participate in the 457B retirement plan with no match. Fire Department employees that do not participate in MainePers can participate in the 457B plan with a 5% match. Scott Littlefield asked if Selectmen could participate. Angela Cushman will find out.
3. Health insurance town employees. The Selectmen approved providing single health coverage at 100% for town employees effective 07/01/2020.

PUBLIC FORUM:

Jeff Nicoletti, Saco Soccer Club, was asking for permission to use of fields as Saco Parks & Recreation is currently not allowing clubs to use fields in Saco. Angela Cushman to follow up with Saco Parks & Recreation.

CORRESPONDENCE:

1. Mailboxes on Steele Rd. The Selectmen reviewed a request to move the mail boxes at the end of Steele Rd to another location further down the road. After discussion with the Road Commissioner the Selectmen are not in favor of the mailboxes being moved and will not be providing a letter for the post office.
2. Recycling comments from a resident. Jarod Harriman to contact resident.
3. SRCC application. Angela Cushman to schedule interested candidate for a future Selectmen meeting.
4. Municipal Election results were provided to the Selectmen.
5. Using metal detector on school/town property. The Selectmen will allow a resident to use a metal detector on school/town property. They only ask that if anything is found to please share their finding with the board.




