EXECUTIVE SESSION:

APPOINTMENTS:

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Roads. Mike Souliere, Road Commissioner, was not able to complete any tree trimming as he had no flaggers. He is going to train his employees to flag so he can get started on the work. The Selectmen are looking to replace another small culvert on Buzzell Road in conjunction with the large culvert on Buzzell Rd being replaced soon. Pricing has not been obtained yet for this small culvert. Mike will work on getting the cement covered at the transfer station.

At the last meeting a resident was present to ask for assistance in dealing with neighbors in items that have placed on town property. Jim Roberts has made contact with the parties involved and will be following up again.

2. Buzzell Rd Culvert. BH2M, the engineering firm, provide an inspection report on the recent work.
3. Fire Commission. The Fire Commission provided information to the Selectmen regarding recent meetings. Fire Chief Hooper sent a memo to the Selectmen regarding Fire Department Long Term Planning. An email will be sent to Chief Hooper.
4. Marijuana moratorium extension – Public Hearing scheduled for 9/18.
5. Time Warner /Spectrum. Tony Vigue provided an update and will connect with Spectrum re: density requirements and recent surveys of Buzzell Rd.
6. Waste Management communication to residents. Selectmen reviewed letter to residents regarding changes to the waste program. The Selectmen would like more information on recycling for businesses.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Electricity at old snack shack. Jim Roberts obtained a quote for removing the electricity. The Selectmen would like to have representation from Little League and Parks & Recreation to discuss.
2. Parks & Recreation Committee. Pat Sughrue is looking for permission to put up a temporary electronic sign for the 5K near the soccer field. Selectmen approved of the request. Pat also asked about parking a Shaw Brothers fire truck out by the office to advertise for the 5K.

PUBLIC FORUM:

A resident communicated she is aware that another resident has marijuana growing in the front yard. This makes the resident uncomfortable and asked the Selectmen to consider this when drafting an ordinance. Jim Roberts encouraged the resident to attend Planning Board meetings when the board is drafting the ordinance.

Dan Gay communicated he had some concerns about a letter from the School Board that went out to residents regarding the current mil rate.

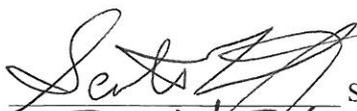

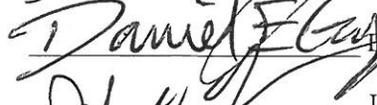

Dan Gay made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:32 PM; 2nd Jarod Harriman Passed 3/0.

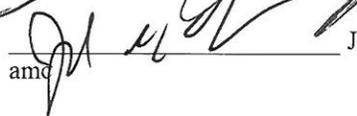
