OLD BUSINESS:

1. Roads. Buzzell Rd is now open for traffic. Mike Souliere stated that another culvert was removed and filled in on Buzzell Rd. The culvert does not require a replacement. Dayton Sand & Gravel will patch the culvert areas and provide a quote on a shim for Buzzell Rd. Mike is looking to do some trim work in the next couple of weeks.
2. Buzzell Rd Culvert. Culverts are now complete. Selectmen reviewed the inspection reports.
3. Fire Commission. FC Rod Hooper asked when the next Joint Selectmen meeting as he interested in the status of the Interlocal Agreement and Personnel Policy. Lyman will be contacted to schedule a future joint meeting. A fire review of the Dayton School was completed today. Rod stated the condition of the school is good and in good working condition.
4. Time Warner/Spectrum. Tony Vigue, consultant, is recommending submitting an updated franchise agreement to Spectrum and then requesting a representative from Spectrum to attend a future Selectmen meeting. An updated franchise agreement will be provided to the Selectmen at the next meeting for review.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Affidavit of Residency. Denis Elie, School Board Chair, communicated that an Affidavit of Residency has been implemented by the Superintendent's Office. Already the school department has received one request for removal from

- Dayton's enrollment which will save the town \$10,000 as a result of this implementation.
2. Snowplow contract/workshop. Selectmen and support staff will meet Nov. 2nd at 6:30 to review current contract.
 3. Recycling workshop. There will be a recycling workshop on Thursday, October 12th, 6PM, Town Office. Erica Bayley of Pine Tree Waste will be present to discuss recycling standards.

PUBLIC FORUM:

Chris L'Heureux was present to discuss the new changes to the waste management program. Chris feels that the new changes discourage businesses from recycling. After some discussion the Selectmen agreed to reconnect with Pine Tree to see what makes sense. Also, Pine Tree has been turning around at his business location and would like that to stop. Selectmen will request this to stop. The Selectmen did state that 99.9% of towns in the State do not subsidize commercial waste or recycling.
