

# SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

October 26, 2020

Selectmen approved agenda.*

## OLD BUSINESS:

1. Roads/Mullet Lane. The town attorney is working on the Mullet Lane easement. Scott Littlefield stated that the work on Hollis Rd so far looks great and has received several compliments from residents. Mike Souliere stated that turnaround on Union Falls is now complete. Mike to follow up on the end of Lambert's driveway and unplug some culverts. Scott will follow up with Dayton Sand & Gravel regarding the shim on Hollis Rd
2. Assessing Services. The Selectmen reviewed and signed the contract with the new assessing agent, Shirley Bartlett.
3. Cable franchise/expansions. Dan Gay stated that he had a conversation with Shelley from Charter regarding some possible expansions and grants. Shelley has agreed to attend an upcoming Selectmen meeting.
4. Property Foreclosures. Automatic foreclosure notices will go out later this week for three properties. The Selectmen agreed to waive foreclosure on two other properties that consist of older trailers that sit on rented land. The waiver stops the foreclosure process for this particular year (2018). The taxes remain outstanding.

## NEW BUSINESS:

1. Appointment of Town Clerk. The Selectmen appointed Jennifer Thibeau as the new town clerk.

## PUBLIC FORUM:

Justin Lord inquired on where the Selectmen stand on establishing a TIF district. There may be a possibility that Justin would be interested in moving a business to Dayton. The business would employ 30-35 employees, looking to have a 25,000 sq ft building and would need 3 phase power. Selectmen stated they would revisit and determine next steps.

Matt Duross, Fire Chief, stated that this morning two employees of Pine Tree Waste received chemical burns from a vapor cloud from some hydrochloric acid that was

disposed in the trash. Chemicals are not household trash and should be properly disposed of. The two employees were transported to the hospital.




