OLD BUSINESS:

1. Roads/Salt Barn. Scott Littlefield asked about reimbursing Paul Poirier, snowplow contractor, for the salt & sand for residents to use for walkways. Jarod Harriman suggested that we should consider this for the next contract. Scott suggested that maybe putting up a sign "Residents Only". Scott communicated that Paul has stated that the changes to the salt shed is working out great. Scott also suggested that the light on the salt shed be adjusted for the new loading area.
2. Fire Commission. The Fire Commission communicated that James Gambino has been hired as a Full-Time GMFR employee. The Commission also provided an informational report. The Fire Chief provided a memo that was issued to Town Clerks, Selectmen Clerks, Treasurers and General Assistance Directors regarding the protocol to follow when residents ask about ambulance bills.
3. Steele Rd. Dan Gay and Jim Roberts met with Wayne Michaud. Wayne Michaud communicated that his property on Steele Rd is now for sale so the easement cannot be done at this time.
4. Discontinued Rd. No update as this time. Abutters will be invited to attend a meeting late January to hear comment on damages.
5. Moratorium on marijuana. Several pieces of information were provided to the Selectmen from David Ordway, Town Attorney. The items provided were a draft of a Marijuana Moratorium and the State Statute relating to moratoriums. A Special Town Meeting will need to be scheduled in order to enact a moratorium on marijuana. A Special Town Meeting will be scheduled as soon as possible.

6. Buzzell Rd Culvert. BH2M is working with the Town to submit an application for the next round of grants to assist towns in addressing culvert issues. The due date is January 17th.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Health Insurance/Pay Increases. **Jarod Harriman made a motion to implement employees paying 10% of the cost for a single employee with the town paying 90%; 2nd Dan Gay. Passed 3/0.** Pay increases will be determined to offset this change.

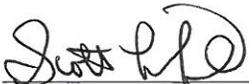
