

## Did you know that the Town of Dayton is now offering a Curbside ZERO-SORT Recycling Service?

With Zero-Sort Recycling, we're making it easier for you to recycle. All paper, cardboard, plastic, glass, metal, and more can be tossed into **one container** without the need to separate. Just use any container of your choice as long as it is 32 gallons or smaller. The container needs to be marked with either a recycling sticker (available at the Town Office free of charge) or with the word "recycle" in bold letters so the drivers can easily identify your recycling container.

***Your recycling collection day is Monday; the same day as trash pickup. There are two trucks going through town; one for trash and one for recycling.***

### Is the recycling program mandatory?

No. The program is completely voluntary. However, the more the town recycles the more money the town saves.

**The town pays \$71.50 per ton to dispose of trash.** There is *no charge to dispose of recycling materials*. Last year we spent approximately \$58,000 to dispose of trash.

### Can you guess how much the town recycled the first week of the Curbside ZERO-SORT recycling?

**2.48 tons of recycling**

That is approximately a \$177 savings to the Town just for one week!

This is a great start! This was more than we collected in the recycling containers that were located at the Town Office.

### And how much trash do you think was collected last week?

**16.96 tons of trash**

Bet there was some recyclables in there!

Clearly, this is a worthwhile effort both financially and ecologically. We encourage your participation.
