Meeting Minutes were read from November 21, 2017. John Boissonnault made a motion to accept the minutes and Darren Adams seconded the Motion. All voted in favor.

**Old Business:**

Dan said we are going to go over the work Shannon has done on the marijuana regulations.

Shannon passed out a copy of Saco's ordinance for marijuana and went over it. She also gave out copies of the work she has done on Dayton's proposed ordinance.

Jim said he thinks we should take this material home and study it and when we come to the next meeting see what we want to do. He noted that one drawback Dayton has is that we do not have a local police department.

Dan said that we should work the licensing, including fees and penalties, into our ordinance. Shannon stated that she will do this.

Much discussion was had as to what the Board felt should go into the ordinance. Shannon will make the noted changes. The Board agreed to go over the ordinance at the next meeting and make any other alterations if necessary.

**New Business:**

The Board has received a Request from Justin and Amanda Normand, 62 C lark Street, Saco, Maine for a storage building on 1090 New County Road. This is a property they are considering purchasing.

Jim said that this is a two-acre lot in a Mixed Use District. If commercial, there is not enough acreage. They would need three acres. If it is an accessory building for their own use, they would be able to do it as they would have enough acreage.

Darren made a motion to adjourn and Shannon seconded it. The meeting adjourned at 8:00 PM. The next meeting will be on Tuesday, January 23, 2018, at 6:30 PM at the Dayton Town Office.
