

TOWN OF DAYTON
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT
Monday, September 22, 2025, at 6:00 pm

To: Brian Pellerin, a constable in the Town of Dayton, in the County of York, State of Maine:

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Dayton in said County of York, Maine, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to assemble at the Dayton Municipal Building on Monday the 22nd day of September 2025 A.D. at 6 o'clock in the evening then and there to act upon the following article, to wit:

ARTICLE 1. To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to approve the Select Board's periodic release of funds appropriated each year to the Capital Fund and carried forward to the following dedicated funds: GMFR Capital Equipment (aka vehicles) Fund; Fire Water Hydrant Fund; GMFR Facilities, Systems Fund; GMFR Building Capital Fund. Any such release shall be for the purposes intended for those funds.

Select Board Recommendation: *Yes vote*

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to increase the budget by \$100,000.00 to cover an anticipated shortfall in the waste contract, tipping fees and transfer station/recycling costs, such increase to come from the General Fund.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to increase the budget by \$40,000.00 to cover an anticipated shortfall in the cost of auditing and accounting services, such increase to come from the General Fund.

Select Board Recommendation: *Yes vote*

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Select Board (i) to enter into an Interlocal Solid Waste Agreement with other municipalities for the purpose of owning and operating ECO Maine, a nonprofit corporation that handles and processes solid waste and recyclable materials; (ii) to enter into a Waste Handling and Recycling Agreement with an indefinite term between the Town and ECO Maine for the handling, processing and recycling of the Town's residential waste; and (iii) to have the Town issue a \$338,108.00 general obligation promissory note (the "Note") to finance the buy-in to join ECO Maine, which Note may be made callable and shall have a term of 30 years at 0% interest and payable in annual installments of

\$11,270.00. The first payment to be made on or before October 1, 2025, will come from the General Fund.

2. Estimated Costs of Proposed Bonds

The estimated costs of this bond issue will be \$338,108.00 in principal and \$0.00 in interest.

3. Validity

The validity of the bond and of the voters' ratification of the bond may not be affected by any error in the above estimated costs of the Proposed Bond. If the actual amount of the total debt service for the bond issue varies from the estimate, the ratification by the voters is nevertheless conclusive and the validity of the bond issue is not affected by reason of the variance.

All three the foregoing (i), (ii) and (iii) must be approved for Article 5 to take effect.




